# **Team, Coach and Volunteer Entitlements**

## 1. Standard Equipment List

The Club will provide the following for new teams or if items need to be replenished:-

- Training balls (size 3,4,5) and two match balls per team (**Note**: the league provides these for mixed teams).
- Ball pump/needles.
- Bibs (please state colours, sizes, and quantity).
- Cones (sports markers/super disc/flat spot; please state colours and quantity).
- Captain's armbands, tactics board, poles (long or 2-part split).
- Goals, corner posts, flags and assistant referee flags (if needed).
- First Aid kit/refills (check for expired items; some only last a season); 5-10 cold packs for each team.

## 2. Funded Coach Qualifications

The club will pay for the following:

i) DBS, ii) FA Safeguarding Children, iii) FA First Aid, iv) FA Introduction to Coaching Football qualifications.

- The only condition is a general expectation of at least 1-2 seasons of Club volunteering in return.

The Club will also fund:

v) UEFA C qualifications for coaches.

- Being more expensive, there is a greater condition to commit to running in-house CPD events for club coaches.
- And/or act as a mentor for less experienced coaches at the Club.
- Both over the following two years.

## 3. Christmas and End of Season Events

- Now that we have established a central clubhouse at Elcot Lane, separate team budgets will no longer be necessary.
- We will use the clubhouse as much as possible as our new and ongoing home.
- Practically, the club will confirm arrangements for each event in advance, including how bookings will be coordinated.

## Christmas

All teams are invited to utilise the Clubhouse for their Christmas event (subject to availability).

Purpose: A MYFC Christmas Party opportunity for individual teams, should teams so wish.

### Format:

- Teams will organise their own party food and occupy the clubhouse.
- The party can be in whatever reasonable form within the clubhouse as each team sees fit (e.g. disco, fancy dress).
- It is fine/encouraged if different teams wish to combine with other age groups to make it a more sizeable party.
- Weather and pitch condition permitting, football beforehand *may be* possible (outside only).
- (Other Christmas event venues/arrangements can be organised by any team, at the team's own expense).

#### End-of-Season

All teams are requested to attend an end-of-season event at the clubhouse, usually in May.

Purpose: A club-wide celebration each year, for teams to award player trophies, speeches of thanks, and squad photos. Format:

- A fully organised weekend for all teams in the club, with a staffed cash bar and food.
- Utilisation of the clubhouse, c.30-60 minutes for each team.
- All players to attend in kit for photographs.
- Weather and pitch condition permitting, football beforehand may be possible (outside only).

## **4. Funded Summer Tournament Entry Fees**

- The Club will cover entry fees for several small-sided teams per age group.
- The exact number of team entries that the Club will fund depends on the size of your playing squad.
- Objective: All available players in a squad are given the chance to play in one summer tournament.

## **5. Funded Coaches' Jackets**

- For coaches who coach regularly AND have completed/committed to complete the FA Intro to Coaching Football Course.
- The Club will pay £40 towards the purchase of a MYFC-branded coaching jacket.
- Orders are placed via Kit Manager and using the Club's kit supplier.

Note: All costs to be agreed in advance, with reimbursement via provision of course/other receipt with bank details to the Club Treasurer.
