General Provisions and Emergency Club Contacts:

All MYFC teams have at least one team official with an in date FA Introduction to First Aid in Football (IFaIF) qualification as required by the FA. MYFC is currently working towards all active coaches having this qualification.

All MYFC teams are issued with an emergency First Aid kit and all team managers are reminded on at least an annual basis to check that their kit remains in date. New and top-up kits are procured and distributed by MYFC's Equipment Manager and funded by the Club.

All MYFC teams have access to emergency contact details and medical information concerning their players and are instructed to have this information available to coaches at training and on match days, ensuring personal data concerning players is protected.
